

## **Expression of Interest – Dressage Judges Taskforce**

DWA are seeking expressions of interest (EOI) for two (2) accredited dressage judges to join the Dressage Judges Taskforce. If you have the following you would be welcomed to apply:

- Current EA Judges accreditation
- Judging experience
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Competent in computer skills
- Able to work independently and in a team
- Strong customer focus
- Conflict resolution skills
- Integrity and confidentiality

The initial term would be for 3 years with the ability to reapply.

### **Roles and Responsibility:**

Improve the standard of dressage judging in WA by:

1. Providing educational opportunities to judges and aspiring judges in WA.
2. Facilitating the delivery of compulsory seminars and workshops for judges, mentors, and judge educators to gain or maintain their EA judge's accreditation as per the EA Dressage Rules.
3. Facilitate the accreditation of new judges and upgrading judges in WA.
4. Assess the need for and facilitate further educational opportunities for judges including mentoring, small group educational sessions and access to Interstate and International experts where possible.
5. Maintain a register of the accreditation status of all WA Dressage Judges, Mentors and Judge Educators as per the Equestrian Australia Dressage Officials Committee (EADOC).
6. Administer matters relating to the appointment of dressage judges at events and competitions.
7. Apply for funding to administer and advance judges education
8. Receive funds, approve payments, and acquit funds required to administer tasks.
9. Report to and liaise with Dressage WA and EADOC
10. Other matters relating to Dressage judging that may be referred from the Dressage WA or EADC.

Members of the DJTF must abide by the Code of Conduct Policy and Conflict of Interest Policy of EA.

Note: DJTF may advise but does not deal with complaints against judges or questions of rule interpretation. These are referred to Dressage WA or the Branch Disciplinary Committee or to EA.

**ELECTION PROCEDURE**

1. Nominations shall be returned to the Chair of DJTF by email as per the details above. The Chair of DJTF shall act as the Returning Officer.
2. It is the responsibility of each individual signing this form to ensure they are **eligible financial members** of EWA and to ensure the form is received by the Returning Officer prior to the closing of nominations. Any nomination will be deemed invalid if it fails to meet either of the above requirements.
3. Every nomination must be accompanied by a **resume** of the nominee comprising not more than two hundred (200) words. In the event that any resume so provided exceeds two hundred (200) words, the Chair may elect to disregard the resume altogether as if it had not been received. The resume should include the following:

  - Committee responsibilities undertaken
  - Reason/objectives of the nominee
  - Equestrian history
  - Business experience
  - General comments
