REMEMBER!

- Rule 9.25 refers to the requirements to remain NOAS accredited
- You have two years to fulfill your reaccreditation requirements
- Your Seminar must be at your level
- Workshops are considered professional development and educational activities and make you a better Judge
- **Official events** – You are required to judge 4 Official events at your level
- **Other events** – You are required to judge 2 other event at any level up to your highest level e.g. Official, Associate, AHRC, Eventing
- H Level Judges – you are required to judge at 4 Associate/Club events at Preliminary/Novice level- this can include Eventing dressage
- The Open Rule Book Test (ORBT) will be available from approx. 1 February 2014 (to be completed by 31/3/14) and can be completed online or in a downloadable copy. Keep an eye on the Equestrian Australia website closer to the date
- **Don't forget your 12 points** – the tables for recording these and how you achieve them are on the following pages
- Attendance at Seminars, workshops and other activities (except Judging) must be signed off by the coordinator unless a certificate of attendance is issued
